This informs you that 22 Owners Association, Inc. has recently been named as a defendant in a lawsuit. The lawsuit is entitled Caroline Vertongen and Tony Vertongen v. 22 Station Owners Association, The Village at Squaw Valley USA, Tremigo Mexican Kitchen and Tequila Bar and Does 1-20. It is filed as Case Number S-CV-0049804 with the Placer County Superior Court.

The plaintiffs (Vertongens) are alleging noise and vibration are emanating from the fan and exhaust system of Tremigo, which is a restaurant located in the commercial space below the plaintiffs' condominium unit.
